to school at an earlier time as teachers need to be finished at 8.45 to ensure they can get to class on time.

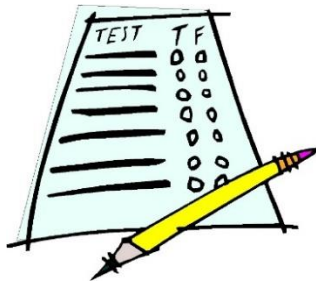
Uniform
